VigorFly 200 is a compact broadband router with 802.11n WLAN network. Its Ethernet WAN port can connect to VDSL/VDSL2/GPON/G.SHDSL /ADSL2+/ADSL/cable modem while you have fixed line. The NAT throughput can easily manage time-critical multimedia streaming. It's easy for family or friends to hook up PCs via embedded 10/100 Ethernet LAN switch to enjoy multimedia applications. Two antennas provide you with speedy WLAN networking. If you are out of coverage of fixed line, you can directly plug 3.5G USB modem to USB port on VigorFly 200.

- Add new menu of **Product Registration**.
- Add new Telnet command to display the command list,

- Support new models of 3G dongle.

- Fixed: When unplug/plug WAN line for several times, WAN connection would be unable to recover, and 3G would redial.
